De réir Chuid 8 de na Rialacháin um Pleanáil & Forbairt 2001, arna leasú, tugtar fógra leis seo go bhfuil sé beartaithe ag Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe Stáisiún Dóiteáin nua a thógáil i mBaile an Charraín Theas, Baile Átha an Rí. Áirítear sna tógairí, obair leis an suíomh a ghlanadh, túr oiliúna, comharthaíocht, tírdhreachú, páircéal, ceangail nua leis na seirbhísí atá ann, agus gach obair forbartha eile a bhaineann leis an suíomh.

Tugadh faoi phróiseas Scagadh Measúnachta Tionchar Timpallachta 1 ndáil leis an bhforbairt atá beartaithe, agus tá cinneadh deanta ag Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe nach mbeidh tionchar suntasach ag an scéim ar an timpallacht, agus dá bharr sin nach bhfuil Measúnacht Tionchar Timpallachta de dhíth.

Tugadh faoi scagadh 'Measúnacht Chur' le linn Chéim 1 don fhorbairt dheartaithe agus tá cinneadh deanta ag Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe nach bhfuil 'Measúnacht Chur' Céim 2 [Ráiteas Tionchar Náruál de dhíth.

In accordance with Part 8 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 as amended, notice is hereby given that Galway County Council proposes the construction of a new Fire Station at Ballygarran South, Atheny, County Galway. Proposals include site clearance works, a training tower, signage, landscaping, parking, connections to existing services, public footpaths and all associated site development works.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Screening process was undertaken for the proposed development, and Galway County Council has concluded that the scheme would not have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore an Environmental Impact Assessment is not required.

A Stage 1 'Appropriate Assessment' screening was carried out for the proposed development and Galway County Council has concluded that a Stage 2 'Appropriate Assessment' (Natura Impact Statement (NIS)) is not required.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment, or on a European site.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or for purchase for a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, during normal office hours (Monday to Friday, 9.00am - 4.00pm), excluding Bank Holidays and Public Holidays, and subject to managed access arrangements due to Covid-19 control measures, for a period of 4 weeks from the 23 July 2021 to the 20 August 2021, at the following location:

Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing L-4506-68; at Roosunmore/Owenbristy, west of Ardahan village, between the townland of Parkaleva and crossroads on the R347, from 8:00 a.m. on Monday 27/09/2021 to 5:00 p.m. on Friday 29/10/2021 to facilitate flood related, road raising.

Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council has made an order closing the following routes from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday 1st August 2021 to facilitate hosting of triathlon event in Loughrea:

- R351 from its junction with the L-4213 - "Tynagh Road" - to its junction with the L-4214 "Earlsparc Junction";
- L-4214 from its junction with the R351 - "Earlsparc Junction" to its junction with the L-4216 "Kilnadeema Cross";

Alternative Route

Travelling from Loughrea traffic will be diverted to the L-4214 - "Tynagh Road" - for 4km, turning right onto the L-8224 at the Glennasat Junction. Continue on this road until arriving at the R351. Travelling from Woodford traffic will be diverted to the L-4215, continuing past "Kilnadeema Cross" until arriving at the R351.
