- 1.60% *Leucanthemum vulgare* - Oxeye Daisy
- 1.60% *Malva moschata* - Musk Mallow
- 1.60% *Plantago lanceolata* - Ribwort Plantain
- 1.60% *Pteridium aquilinum* ssp. *caespitosum* - Scaled Brumet
- 0.70% *Ranunculus acris* - Meadow Buttercup
- 0.50% *Rhinanthus minor* - Yellow Rattle
- 0.50% *Daucus carota* - Wild Carrot
- Grasses 90%
- 9.00% *Agrostis capillaris* - Common Bent
- 31.50% *Cynosurus cristatus* - Crested Dogtail
- 27.00% *Festuca rubra* - Red Fescue
- 4.50% *Poa trivialis* - Smaller Cat's-tail
- 18.00% *Poa pratensis* - Smooth-stalked Meadow-grass
