  - Disability compliant parking bays
  - Multi use games area (MUGA) & Futsal courts with lighting to allow year-round use
  - Reclaimed granite sets from town centre development to create shorefront viewpoints
  - 200m self compacting gravel running route
  - Pump track, see specialist designer information for further detail
  - Children's play trail with natural obstacles and sensory planting
  - Amphitheatre performance space created utilising existing topography, gabion bleacher with timber top
  - Grass steps providing viewing area for running track and dwelling space for older children
  - Disability compliant ramp, max gradient 1:20.5
  - Proposed destination for relocated tree sculpture
  - Retaining features to facilitate disability compliant path, see engineer's information for further detail
