Note	First of all my wife Aoibhinn and I are not against the location of the graveyard. We have serious concerns about the location of the entrance to the graveyard and the car park. It is beyond belief how few car parking spots are proposed and for those few cars that do get in to park there is no way to turn properly. If there was an emergency in our road at the time of a funeral it would be blocked up with no way in or out as people would have to abandon cars everywhere. I understand for sightlines the entrance is proposed up the boreen but there is enough sightlines on the bend at the head of the boreen especially when you take in to consideration how bad the roads are and the pace people have to drive at on these roads, no more than 20-30km per hour coming from the Headford side due to the bends on the road. Also the advantage of having the entrance at the head of the road and cutting straight across the field is the hedgerow on the boreen would be saved. With the rich heritage going back 100's of years to propose a concrete stake and chain link fence as opposed to stone walls is not in keeping with the local area and would really take from locality. I hope you can take these points into consideration and revise the plans and give the locality a much needed graveyard.
