

## **GALWAY COUNTY COUNCIL - SITE NOTICE**

## Ballyglass East, Ardrahan, Co. Galway.

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given that Galway County Council proposes to carry out a development at the above location (townland: Ballyglass East) comprising of the demolition of an existing dwelling and the construction of a 2-bedroom dwelling, together with proprietary effluent treatment plant, percolation area and ancillary site works.

A Stage 1 'Appropriate Assessment' screening was carried out for the proposed development and Galway County Council has concluded that a Stage 2 'Appropriate Assessment' [Natura Impact Statement (NIS)] is not required.

<u>Plans and particulars</u> of the proposed development will be available for inspection or for purchase for a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, during normal office hours (Monday to Friday, 9.00am – 4.00pm, excluding Bank Holidays and Public Holidays) <u>for a period of 4 weeks from Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021 until Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2021 at the following locations:</u>
