In accordance with Part 8 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 as amended, notice is hereby given that Galway County Council proposes to carry out an 8no. unit housing development comprising of; 2no. single storey two-bed dwellings, 6no. two-storey two-bed dwellings and all ancillary site development works, including road enhancement works along the R360 Regional Road, at Durrow, & Ballaghymurry, Ballymoe, Co. Where any person considers that the proposed development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment, he or she may, at any time before the expiration of 4 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have such effects.

A Stage 1 'Appropriate Assessment' screening was carried out for the proposed development and Galway County Council has concluded that a Stage 2 'Appropriate Assessment' [Natura Impact Statement (NIS)] is not required.
