



PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED) AND PART 8 OF THE PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 (AS AMENDED)

Development at: Existing Building on junction of Northgate Street & Burkes Lane, Athenry, Co. Galway.

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, Galway County Council propose to carry out the following works:

- Change of use, renovation and refurbishment of former Restaurant / Take Away / Offices and Place of Worship as granted under previously planning ref. no's 06/3553 and 07/5217 to a multi-purpose community and enterprise facility with public reception area, multi-use offices, meeting rooms and supporting spaces.
- The proposed development includes connection to existing services, associated site works and new signage.

The subject works are located within the Athenry Architectural Conservation Area.
