Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given that Galway County Council proposes to carry out a development at the above location (townland: Ballygar) comprising of the construction of a 4-bedroom dwelling, together with connection to existing services and ancillary site works.

A Stage 1 'Appropriate Assessment' screening was carried out for the proposed development and Galway County Council has concluded that a Stage 2 'Appropriate Assessment' [Natura Impact Statement (NIS)] is not required.
