1. Ba chóir do dhaoine a bheidh ag dul ón Llonán i dtreo na Gaillimhe nó i dtreo dheisceart Chonamara dul bóthar an N59 An Llonán-An Choill Mhór, dul ar bhóthar an R344 Gleann Eidhneach i mBaile na Coille Móire agus ansin bóthar an N59 An Clochán-Bóthar na Gaillimhe sa tSraith Salach.
2. Is féidir leosan freisin a bheidh ag dul ó Chonga-Chorr na Móna dul bóthar an R345 An Mám-Conga, bóthar an R346 Conga-An Chrois, bóthar an R334 An Chrois-Áth Cinn agus bóthar an N84 Áth Cinn-Gaillimh.

ROADS ACT 1993 - SECTION 75 ROADS REGULATIONS 1994 - ARTICLE 12 NOTICE OF DECISION

Conamara Municipal District

Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council has made an order closing a section of the R336 between An Mám and Maam Cross from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 29/10/2024 in order to facilitate the Maam Cross Fair.

Alternative Route:

1. Those travelling from the Leenane direction towards Galway or south Conamara should use the N59 Leenane-Kylemore road turning onto the R344 Gleann Eidhneach road at Kylemore Village and then the N59 Clifden-Galway Road at Sraith Salach.
2. Those travelling from the Conga-Corr na Móna direction may also use the R345 An Mám-Conga Road, the R346 Conga Cross Road, the R334 Cross-Headford Road and the N84 Headford-Galway Road.
3. Those travelling from Galway to North Conamara should consider option No. 2 in reverse depending on their destination.

Local vehicular access will not be permitted.

Pursuant to the provisions of Part XI of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended) and in accordance with the requirements of Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Galway County Council proposes the construction of a new Fire Station at St Lawrence's Fields, Athenry Road, Loughrea, Co. Galway.

Proposals include the following:

- A single storey, 3-Bay Fire station with training yard,
