


# THE PROCESS AND THE TCF POLICY

The Ballinasloe Town Centre First
Plan is being developed by the Ballinasloe
Town Team, in collaboration with Galway
County Council and The Paul Hogarth Company
on behalf of local people..

The process focuses on engagement and collaboration, and has been driven by the findings from the first consultation and the insights from the town representatives on the Town Team. The Town Centre First (TCF) Policy is a government initiative that aims to prioritise the regeneration and revitalisation of town centres, focusing on making them more attractive, sustainable, and vibrant places to live, work, and visit.







#### WHAT BALLINASLOE HAD TO SAY... FROM THE 1ST CONSULTATION

The first consultation findings highlighted that Ballinasloe is an attractive

town with a well-planned layout and popular shops, facilities, and amenities. However, dereliction of key landmarks is affecting its overall appearance.

Local people have a strong interest in further developing the town centre, especially in relation to businesses, employment, and retail. Many opportunities were identified, including: enhancement of the public realm, improvement of green and blue spaces like the river and Fair Green, as well as the potential for residential development in the town centre, and to bring forward better facilities for young and old.


















The FAIR GREEN will enhance the town's animation through special and exciting events and reimagine itself as a space designed for play and other everyday uses for everyone.




PROJECT: BALLINASLOE **STORIES** 



The **VACANT BUILDINGS** will discover new opportunities to revitalise the town centre through landmark buildings and overhead spaces for community, residential, and commercial use.








f. PROJECT:
