I live directly opposite the proposed new graveyard.


My main request is that the entrance to the graveyard be on the main road and that the bóithrín to the wood remains untouched.

- 2. The proposal to tear down beautiful trees, hedges and stone walls and replace them with concrete posts and mesh fencing will destroy the character of the bóithrín as a walking amenity. The removal of the hill is also totally unnecessary.
