- Not for profit organisations


The Model

Annual Membership

- €100 per year
- Commencing September 2025
- Includes use of the event space and facilities, hourly or by event
- Subject to availability via calendar booking
- Bookings can be made 6 months in advance
- 2025/2026 membership for the first 35 groups to register is being funded though Creative Ireland
- All funds generated are repatriated back into the Courthouse
